Dear Residential Care residents and families

Following my communication with you last week I'm writing to keep you up-to-date regarding the status of the outbreak in our Rosebank wing.

Unfortunately, we have seen another Resident of Rosebank test positive for COVID-19.

As we know from experience containing the spread of the virus in a dementia wing such as Rosebank is difficult.

Residents of Rosebank who have not tested positive and have no symptoms, continue to be able to participate in external visits.

In addition, residents who tested positive at the outset of this current outbreak who have since recovered and have completed their isolation period can once again participate in outside visits.

Our COVID-19 testing regime will continue into next week. If no further residents test positive over the coming days we are optimistic of being in a position to commence de-escalation of Rosebank next week. However, as always, we will be guided by the Local Public Health unit in this regard.

I thank you once again for your support and understanding as we navigate our way through this current COVID-19 wave which is having widespread impact on all of our families, friends and the broader community.
