We have one resident of Rosebank who based on the advice of the Public Health Unit must remain in isolation for a few more days. This means that in-room visits will not be possible in Rosebank until Monday 8 August.

Once again, we thank all of our residents and families for their support through this outbreak and to our wonderful staff for their ongoing efforts in providing care to our residents in challenging conditions.
