Dear Residential Care residents and families

Further to our previous communications, we wanted to provide an update on the status of the outbreak in our Lillipilli wing.

We are very pleased to advise that our monitoring and testing has not identified any further positive cases among residents of Lillipilli and NSW Health has authorised de-isolation of the wing.

We have advised Lillipilli residents and contacted their families directly to let them know this news.

Lillipilli residents are now able to move about the facility once again, in addition to enjoying visits in the plaza.

We have a small number of Lillipilli residents who, based on the advice of the Public Health Unit will remain in isolation for a few more days. This means that for now in-room visits will not be possible in Lillipilli. We will advise as soon as these again become possible.

Once again, we thank all our impacted residents and families for working with us to bring this outbreak to a swift conclusion.
